

## Master's in Hotel Administration (HOA) Degree Program Course Overview for Incoming Fall 2022 Recruits

The HOA program has been revised for all students entering Fall 2022 and forward. Below are the options for completing the revised 31-credit Master's in Hotel Administration (HOA) degree program.

**NOTE: Core courses must be completed as outlined below. Students cannot complete just one core course.** Each core is a 5-week session and are taught back-to-back. In Fall 2022, the core courses are taught on-campus on Tuesdays from 2:30 to 5:15 pm starting with HOA 701 for the first 5-weeks, HOA 734 for the second 5-weeks, and then HOA 746 for the last 5-weeks.
